


Transporting

What's the risk?

• Residue on drug containers
• Residue on final prepared product
• Accidental spills during transport

• Single pair chemocertified gloves
• Transport in sealed plastic bags
• Use impact-resistant packing materials
• Use secure connector pieces (e.g., luer lock caps, closed system transfer devices)

Cleaning


What's the risk?


• When cleaning the pharmacy or the biologic safety cabinet


• Double pair of chemo-certified gloves
• Gown
• Eye/face protection
• Mask
• Apply cleaning solution with wipes, not spray
